## THEME Sessions

WE'VE DEVOTED ABOUT 50% OF SCHEDULED CAMP TIME TO DEVELOP AND WORK ON YOUR 2023 THEME.

- **Theme Development:** Quick large group sessions, focusing on one aspect of theme (Verbal, Visual, Ladder/Coverage)
- **School Theme Groups:** You'll meet with your theme coach to deconstruct what you learned in the Theme Development session and how to use it with your theme.
- **Theme check-in by school:** One-on-one sessions with your theme coach for Q&A, ideas and advice about how to move forward
- **Theme Work Parties:** All schools will meet in one large room where you'll have access to the entire staff to get even more Q&A, ideas and advice.

## "What if?" tracks

EACH ATTENDEE SIGNS UP FOR ONE "WHAT IF" TRACK

- **The Idea:** Instead of taking a class on "design" or "photography," we want to focus on a process, a specific assignment where you'll learn something new and have something to contribute to your theme packet.
- **Class content:** We'll present an idea, share a library of examples and assign a project, one you can use in your 2023 book. For example, "What if we made inspiration our own?" would include finding visual inspiration from a magazine or other source, copying that example exactly and then designing a version of it that could work in your yearbook and with your theme.

## CHOICE sessions

THREE BLOCKS. TWO SESSIONS PER BLOCK. 30 CHOICES, SIX OF WHICH YOU CAN SAMPLE.

- **Color Coded:** Each "What If" track will have three choice sessions that expand on your topic. So, the "Inspiration" track might include choice sessions on typography, color palettes and photo packaging.

- **BBQ:** The first night's dinner is held outside so you can easily mix and mingle with your new yearbook friends.
- **Yearbook Exchange:** Bring extra copies of your 2022 book so you can trade with others.
