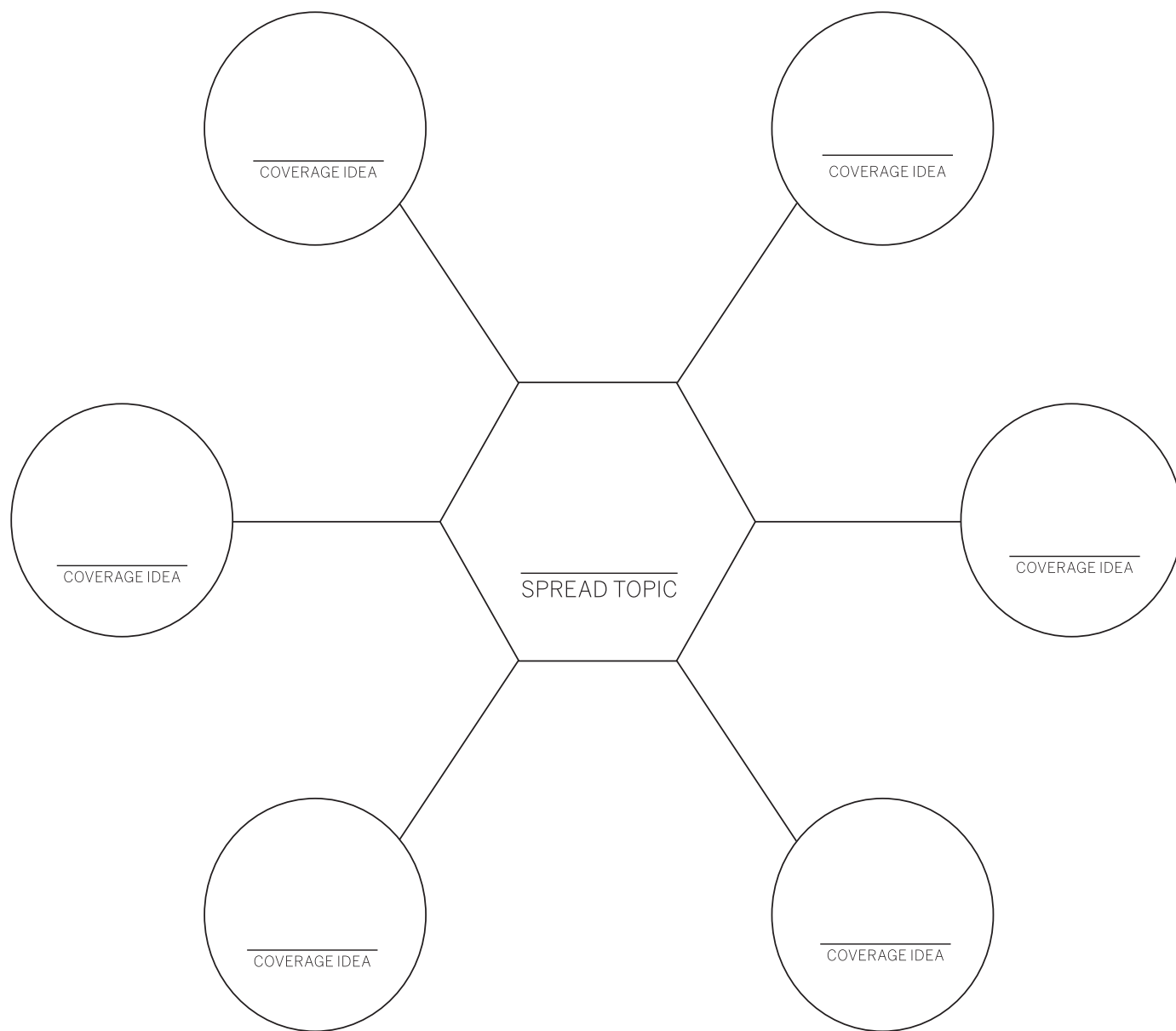


PLANNING AHEAD
